SUMMARY

Following an Art School education I have worked in puppetry, cabaret, street theatre and devised performance as a performer, writer, director and maker. I created and compered Edinburgh's original *Bongo Club Cabaret*, concurrently performing with the Edinburgh Puppet Company for 5 years. I performed over 200 times in the street theatre show, 'The Incredible Bull Circus', and in 2009 I began making indoor work as 'Inconvenient Spoof' with Silvia Mercuriali, also co-writing her audio tour 'Wondermart'. In have performed throughout the UK and Ireland, in France, Belgium, Holland, Finland, New Zealand, Australia, Canada, Japan and China.
